

## **Safety**

We can't stress enough to everyone how important it is to practice good safety during Great Days of Service. Please be aware and on the lookout for any and all safety issues. If you see something that is an issue or someone acting in an unsafe manner notify your project leader or anyone at the project desk. We want this to be an accident free event. Below are a few reminders:

1. If doing yard work, running a weedeater, clearing brush and trash be sure to wear the proper clothing, long pants (no shorts), gloves, safety glasses, no open toed shoes. We will have safety glasses and gloves available at the check in area.
2. If working in a dusty environment be sure to wear a breathing mask. We will have some available at the check in area.
3. Be sure to clear the area of all trash and debris before mowing or running a weed eater.
4. Be on the lookout for wasp, snakes, poison ivy, and poison oak. We will have cans of wasp spray available at the check in area.
5. If working with a metal ladder be aware of power lines that might come in contact with ladder.
6. Drink plenty of water, stay hydrated. We will have bottled water at the check in area. Also use a good insect repellent and you may want to use a good sun screen.
